

Aaron J. Fogelson Dies in Zumbrota

ZUMBROTA — Aaron J. Fogelson, resident here for 31 years, died yesterday at the Zumbrota Community hospital where he had been confined for four weeks. He was 82 years old.

Mr. Fogelson was born March 26, 1873, in Cherry Grove township, Goodhue county. He married Emma Starch in 1900 and she preceded him in death.

Surviving are a son, George of Zumbrota; two daughters, Mrs. Ervie Swenson of Zumbrota, Mrs. Bernard Swenson of St. Paul; a sister, Mrs. Minnie Thompson of Black River Falls, Wis.; seven grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.
