TAYLOR, Wis.—Mrs. Minnie Johnson, 82, died Saturday, Sept. 14, at a Black River Falls nursing home, leaving 174 direct descendants.

Services will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday, at Taylor Lutheran Church, Rev. W. H. Winkler officiating, and burial will be in Upper Beaver Creek Cemetery. Family devotions will be held at 8 p.m. Monday in Jensen Funeral Home, Hixton.
